When. 24 July to 6 August (2 weeks only). Registration starts on 17 July.

How. Read the Bible each day as an individual or a group. Read one chapter or story with no limits. Record your reading on the log.

For each chapter or a story, your sponsor donate an amount or a lump sum at the end.

Take the adhoc quizzes and win prizes. Achievement awards will be given at the Parish Annual Meeting and Winter Lunch on 13 August.

Where. At home, in school, at bedtime or anywhere to help you achieve. There will be a couple of Holy Bibles at the Sacred Heart Chapel in the church where you can read.

Why. Poverty exists everywhere, even in New Zealand. This initiative addresses -
